



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

REQUEST TO EXTEND MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN ZONING APPROVALS

CITY OF BRENTWOOD

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Brentwood will be considering an extension on a Moratorium enacted by the Board on July 16, 2018 on development, improvements, or change of use on property within the Manchester Road Sub-Area as described in the City's Comprehensive Plan. The Moratorium was imposed in order to allow for sufficient time to conduct a proper land use study, afford community engagement, develop a long-range plan for proper development of the area, consideration of any appropriate zoning text amendments and other actions. The Board will consider extending the Moratorium through April 1, 2019. A public hearing will be held, and citizens may offer comment at the meeting of the Board of Aldermen on Monday, January 7, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. Such meeting will be held at the Brentwood City Hall, 2348 S. Brentwood Blvd, Brentwood, Missouri 63144.
