The Process

Step 1: Citizen attends Amnesty Program & Legal Expo on August 11, 15, 18th.

Step 2: Citizen completes workshop segment and receives a voucher

Step 3: Citizen reports to appropriate municipality with voucher to obtain new court date

AMNESTY PROCEDURES FOR

BRENTWOOD MUNICIPAL DIVISION COURT

August 13, 2018 through September 14, 2018 Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm

- 1. Person charged, or family member/friend, can appear at the violations bureau window during business hours listed above with a voucher from Better Family Life.
- 2. Person must post \$100.00 bond for all warrants to be lifted and a future court date to be given.

OR

The \$100.00 can be applied to existing fines and costs after warrants are lifted and person can be placed on a payment plan.
