A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD DECLARING THE CITY-WIDE TRAFFIC CALMING PROGRAM TO BE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE; AUTHORIZING THE USAGE OF A NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (NTMP); AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It is found and declared that a city-wide traffic program protects and enhances the public health safety, and welfare and a proper subject for the exercise of governmental authority.

SECTION 2. The Board of Aldermen hereby adopts and approves the documents and procedures to manage the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) process attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Administrator, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement and manage the NTMP process approved hereby.

SECTION 3. The City Administrator and City Staff are hereby authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to initiate, implement, and manage the NTMP.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
