The Brentwood Days Parade judges determined these three entries best exhibited the “Totally Awesome ‘80s” theme:



What to Know About Election Season and Sign Requirements

The Sign Code is found in Chapter 410 of the Brentwood Municipal Code. Sec. 410.040 (A)(5) allows one ground sign of six (6) square feet or less in all residential districts on private property. This allows residents to display one sign six (6) square feet in size all year round on private property, and the resident does not need to acquire a permit for the sign. This same Code section allows additional ground signs in residential districts during the "Election Season" not to exceed the total number of questions or candidates on the ballot for the election. Elections signs are considered signs with names of candidates and also matters on the ballot (Propositions, for example). These election signs are regulated by the "Election Season." Sec. 410.030 defines "Election Season" as the period from 30 days prior to any election voted in by the residents of Brentwood until 3 days after that election. Keeping Sidewalks, Streets Clean

Section 235.300 of the Brentwood Municipal Code states, "No person shall sweep or deposit in any gutter, street or other public place within the City the accumulation of litter from any building or lot from any public or private sidewalk or driveway. Persons owning or occupying property shall keep the sidewalk in front of their premises free of litter."

Brentwood 2019 Budget Planning

Preliminary budget discussions with the Ways and Means Committee helped by setting parameters and goals that guide the development of the budget. In September, a Citizen Budget Forum at the Ways and Means Committee meeting provided staff with additional information to aid in setting goals and priorities for the 2019 budget.

Throughout the summer months, the department heads prepared their departmental and capital budget requests and then submit them to the City Administrator in October. The Board of Aldermen held a public hearing and adopted by ordinance the 2018 property tax rates that must be submitted to St. Louis County by the statutory deadline of October 1, 2018.

In October, the City Administrator and Finance Director meet with each department to review the budget requests and then put together the proposed budget document. This document is then presented to the Ways and Means Committee at the November meeting.

The Ways and Means Committee may have multiple meetings to discuss the proposed budget and must ultimately forward a final recommended budget to the Board of Alderman for adoption.

The Board of Aldermen must hold a public hearing and adopt the 2019 Annual Budget by ordinance on or before the first meeting in December.

Fall Leaf Vacuum Service

The City of Brentwood is offering leaf-vacuuming service in cooperation with Hendel Lawncare Inc. The cost includes four collections and is offered in two rates, depending on yard size. For properties less than one-half acre, the rate is \$60. For properties one-half acre and larger, the rate is \$100. Residents must order and pay for the service **no later than October 26** to participate in all pickups. Payment is made directly to Hendel Lawncare Inc. Leaves will be vacuumed November 5, November 19, December 3 and December 17. Leaves should be raked between the curb and sidewalk. Please do not rake leaves into the curb line or into the street. Please refrain from parking vehicles near the leaf piles to provide Hendel Lawncare access for its vacuum equipment.

As Brentwood looks forward to its second century, we're working on ambitious plans -- and an exciting opportunity to transform and renew part of our City!

In May 2017, the Board of Aldermen approved three projects to revitalize the Manchester Road corridor. The ultimate goal is to ensure and enhance the City of Brentwood's vibrancy for many years to come.

These transformative initiatives are bound together in building a bright future for Brentwood.

Deer Creek Flood Mitigation

This involves the planning, design and construction of improvements to the Deer Creek Channel to alleviate ongoing flooding problems located along Deer Creek and work to protect affected properties from the 100-year flood plain and more frequent flooding.

Manchester Road Improvements

This is a Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) project focusing on pedestrian and vehicular improvements to Manchester Road within the city limits of Brentwood. The 1.5-mile effort, anticipated to begin in 2020, will consist of a mill and overlay of the existing asphalt pavement; replacement of the existing concrete gutter with curb and gutter; partial access management of existing business entrances; and pedestrian improvements to sidewalks, pedestrian signals and pedestrian crossings. In conjunction with the MoDOT project, the City of Brentwood will implement additional improvements to the overall appearance of Manchester Road, a vital commercial corridor.

Deer Creek Greenway Connector

This involves planning, design and construction of a connection between the City of Brentwood's Rogers Parkway and the Great Rivers Greenway's (GRG) Deer Creek Greenway. In partnership with GRG, the City of Brentwood aspires to connect its residents to the surrounding larger community while at the same time sharing Brentwood's wonderful parks and open space amenities with the region.






