For the Apple consolidated app, users will download the app and the icon that will display on your device will be the CivicMobile app icon. Once you've opened the app, you have the option to search for **Brentwood, MO** or use the "Find Your Location" feature. After selecting the app, it will open directly to the app's menu screen.



## Public Works Updates

The Board of Aldermen updated the **sewer lateral repair program** in February. Resolution 1184.2 involves these changes: Cabling/cleaning blockages is now the property owner's responsibility. The cost ceiling for approved repairs is limited to \$3,500 per calendar year.

The Board of Aldermen passed Resolution 1127.1, allowing **discounts for some optional sanitation services**. A resident who is either age 65 or older or has a medical mobility issue may qualify for a 50% discount on optional sanitation services such as weekly valet (rear yard) trash collections. Contact City Hall for the application form.

Over the past few years, Public Works has provided mosquito adulticide services, a weekly **application of mosquito control spray** in residential areas throughout the city from late May to mid-September. In October 2018, the Board of Aldermen agreed to **discontinue** this service except for special events such as Brentwood Days and Music on the Menu. The City will continue contracting with St. Louis County Vector Control Services for control of mosquito larvae. Residents are urged to remove standing water on their private property and complete other preventive measures to reduce potential mosquito breeding locations.

## Safety Reminders from Your Fire Department



**Check your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors to make sure they are working properly.** Replace old batteries.

A home should include at least one smoke detector for each level of the home, including one in every bedroom and one in each bedroom hallway. If your home has fuel-burning appliances (gas stove or furnace), at least one carbon monoxide detector must be present, located in the bedroom hallway. The fire department can assist with installation of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.

**Review and practice escape plans with your families.**

Designate a meeting place outside of your home should you need it in case of a fire or other emergency.

**BBQ Grills and Fire Pits:** The Fire Department follows St. Louis County ordinances regarding recreational backyard fires. The fire must be contained within a fire ring and be away from area structures. Someone must be present while it burns, have an extinguishing source nearby, and burn wood or similar combustibles; do not burn trash. Barbecue grills and fire pits are not allowed on balconies of condos or apartments.

## Stay Safe This Spring

Enjoy the season and stay safe with tips from the Brentwood Police Department:



When working on chores inside your home with the windows open or doors unlocked and propped open, be mindful of strangers lurking around. Call 911 if anything looks suspicious.

When working in your yard or garden, remember that scattered, unattended items are easy for thieves to take. Be prepared before you begin your projects. Put your tools and equipment away when you're not there.

Beware of solicitors/contractors wanting to pave your driveway, mow your lawn, clean your gutters, repair your roof or enter your home for a bid on any type of work. Never let a stranger inside your home for any reason, unless you have invited them over and have made others aware. Check with neighbors for referrals for needed work around your house.

Utility company personnel will not come to your house unless they have an appointment. Don't get lured into these on-the-spot inspections. If you are approached, ask for company ID and look for their company vehicles.


