
SUSPENSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, I issued a Declaration of Emergency and Executive Order imposing a city-wide curfew on public gatherings between the hours of 10:00 PM and 5:30 AM; and

WHEREAS, I have been advised by the City's Chief of Police that the curfew has successfully served to preserve public safety and assure the wellbeing of those who have taken to our streets and public spaces to engage in this important public discourse; and that the need for continuing those restrictions does not appear to be critical at this point;


NOW, THEREFORE, in accord with the authority referenced in the June 2, 2020, Order, I hereby suspend indefinitely the Executive Order of June 2, 2020, and the curfew restrictions previously imposed, subject to reinstatement if circumstances warrant.
