


Event Pavilion Design Update

Event Pavilion Concept

- 01) Multi-Purpose Event / Classroom Space
- 02) Terrace and 2-sided fireplace
- 03) Restroom Entry / Drinking Fountain
- 04) Facilities Storage (300 nsf)
- 05) Protected Breeze-way entry
- 06) Bike Repair Tool Station
- 07) Furniture Storage (150 nsf)



1,100sf multi-purpose space can support 40 person classroom config and 70 person event (seated inside)

Projection / Teaching Wall


Event Pavilion Concept

Terrace at NE corner with strong connection to the proposed temporary stage location. Also provides for better views to the North and East as well as minimizes the view to the south.

Ball field and playground locations with line of sight to restrooms

Pass-thru + Terrace & Expansion space (lighted lawn) provides for convenient and permeable connection between parking and event lawn

Building footprint avoids MSD easement



Event Space Entry / Pass - Thru



Pass-thru creates protected space at the entry to event space and also a portal / gateway experience connecting to the park / Event Lawn beyond

Event / Classroom Space




800sf multi-purpose space can support a 40 person classroom configuration or a 70 person event (shown here with 8 person round tables)
