

BHL COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS (per current St. Louis County guidelines)

- All patrons in the facility must wear masks. Players and officials **MUST** wear a face covering/shield/mask on the ice including during games, warmups, practices and while training if done indoors.
- Players should arrive at the rink no more than **15 minutes** before the start of on-ice activities. Players will change in the areas directed to by facility staff (per current re-opening guidelines).
 - Showers and water fountains will not be available at this time. Lobby restrooms are open.
 - After the end of the game, players need to exit the building within 15 minutes (and will exit through the designated doors).
- Upon entry to the rink, in addition to the normal BHL sign in process, players will also undergo health screening and temperature checks. Players reporting symptoms of COVID-19, recent contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 or reporting a temperature of 100.4 or more will be asked to leave the building.
- Social distancing **MUST** be maintained as much as reasonably possible during games and while in the building (access to changing areas/locker rooms will be arranged to allow for social distancing and separation of teams).
 - No spitting, no handshake lines or fist bumps.
- Spectators will be directed to sit in the spectator stands, and to maintain social distance from others.

HOLD HARMLESS WAIVER:

I, the undersigned participant, on behalf of myself, my heirs, legatees and assigns, hereby agree to indemnify, save and hold harmless the City of Brentwood or any of their agents, representatives, employees, representatives of the Missouri Ice Hockey Officials Association, or assigns, for my health, safety or injury and or disability arising out of or resulting from participation in this program. I also authorize any photos taken of myself, the participant, to be used in any publicity or promotion materials by the department. By signing this contract, participant declares that they have read, understand and agree to comply with the **HOLD HARMLESS POLICY AND PROVISION FOR INDEMNITY**: In consideration of being allowed to enter upon the land and/or facilities owned or operated by the City of Brentwood or its affiliates, participant agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Brentwood together with its elected and appointed officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns collectively here referred to as **RELEASES**, and each of them from any claim, cause of action, loss, liability, damage, expense or cost, including attorney's fees, incurred or initiated due to or in any way arising from the presence of the participant or the participant's agents employees or guests in or upon the land or facilities owned or operated by the City of Brentwood or its affiliates caused by the negligence of the **RELEASES** or otherwise. Participant expressly agrees that this indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the state of Missouri; and if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

COVID-19 ADDENDUM:

Effective June 15, 2020, the St. Louis County is following the guidance of the Department of Public Health Order for Amended Business and Individual Guidelines for Social Distancing and Re-Opening Order effective June 1, 2020. These guidelines may be replaced or modified by DPH based on new scientific information and local information. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact. Participating in Brentwood Parks and Recreation Department leagues and programs or accessing the City of Brentwood facilities could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19.

The City of Brentwood in no way warrants that COVID-19 infection will not occur through participation in Brentwood Parks and Recreation Department leagues and programs or accessing the City of Brentwood facilities. Failure to comply with all applicable guidelines, protocols, and preventative measures related to COVID-19, including but not limited to the guidelines issued by the CDC, DPH and St. Louis County, may result in the immediate removal from league and forfeiting any fees associated with registration. By signing this addendum, all participants are accepting the inherent risks in utilizing the City of Brentwood facilities and participating in high contact frequency sports where social distancing is not possible and there is physical contact with other athletes.
