Breaking Ground on Brentwood Bound: Destination Playground in Brentwood Park

The City of Brentwood officially broke ground on the destination playground and water play area in the new Brentwood Park (2924 Brazeau Avenue) on November 3.

The playground will offer 2.5 acres of interactive play experience. Many of the playground amenities will be unique to Brentwood Park and not found elsewhere within the St. Louis region.

This imaginative play experience is organized into four key areas:

- **Family Fun Zone**
- **Adventure Play Area**
- **Overlook**
- **Water Play Explorer Creek**

This will be a memorable destination for children and adults, with a focus on creative and inclusive play. The playground is expected to open in Fall/Winter 2023.



West Community Credit Union Partners with City of Brentwood

West Community Credit Union Event Lawn is First Named Feature in New Brentwood Park

The City of Brentwood announced in September that West Community Credit Union has secured naming rights for the event lawn in the new Brentwood Park. West Community is the first sponsor of an amenity in this park.

Brentwood Park is expected to open to the public in spring or summer 2023. Located off South Brentwood Boulevard near Russell Avenue, the park will be the jewel of the Brentwood parks system and a premier park in the metro area.

The West Community Credit Union Event Lawn is a large green space that will be used for open play as well as special events for up to 900 people. The lawn is adjacent to a pavilion and a food truck area.

The park is a component of the City's Brentwood Bound Plan, which includes three projects bound together to build a brighter future for Brentwood: Deer Creek Flood Mitigation, Manchester Road Improvements, and the Deer Creek Greenway Connector.

"West Community Credit Union is honored to be included in the Brentwood Bound development and to support the community we have called home for over 85 years. This partnership will help provide the families of Brentwood and the surrounding communities a beautiful gathering place for many years to come," said Jason Peach, CEO of West Community Credit Union.

West Community Credit Union began as Brentwood Mutual Credit Union in 1936, founded by 15 businesses and civic leaders with \$150 in capital. In 1986, the organization changed its name to West Community Credit Union, with 7,300 members and almost \$9 million in loans. Today West Community has become a progressive financial organization with nearly \$400 million in assets, 27,500 members and over \$350 million in loans.

"The City of Brentwood is thrilled to welcome West Community Credit Union as our first partner and sponsor of Brentwood Park. West Community's investment in and commitment to the Brentwood community will continue to have a lasting impact," said Bola Akande, Brentwood's city administrator.



CITY SERVICES

CodeRED/OnSolve Emergency Notification + Weather Warning Alerts

Sign up to receive notifications of impending emergencies, weather alerts, or critical community alerts via phone, email or text. Click the CodeRED button on the home page of brentwoodmo.org or call 314.963.6710 to sign up. Download the **CodeRED Mobile Alert by Onsolve LLC** mobile app for real-time, location-specific alerts.

Brentwood's CodeRED Community Notification System includes CodeRED Weather Warning, which provides residents and businesses with automated severe weather alerts. Those who choose to opt in to this service will receive flash flood, tornado and severe thunderstorm warnings just moments after an alert has been issued by the National Weather Service.

The City of Brentwood sends other public safety notifications, such as road closures or specific emergency situations, through the CodeRED system. The City of Brentwood CodeRED Assistance Line is 314.963.6710. Please leave your name and phone number, and a staff member will return your call as soon as possible.

There is no charge to residents or businesses for this service.

Knox HomeBox Loan Program

The Brentwood Fire Department offers a 90-day Knox HomeBox loan program for residents who have a temporary special need or physical disability preventing them from opening their front door to Brentwood fire and medical personnel in event of an emergency. Call 314.963.8612.

MAGIC Bus

This free service is designed to transport Brentwood residents age 60 and older or adults with disabilities to destinations within Brentwood and surrounding communities. To learn more, call 314.963.8685.

Open Space Council Provides \$50,000 Grant to Brentwood

The Open Space Council for the St. Louis Region Executive Director Bonnie Harper and Board President David Wilson presented a \$50,000 check to the City of Brentwood for the purchase of land for the Brentwood Wetland Arboretum Restoration Project.

This gift will assist the City of Brentwood in obtaining the land located between the Bi-State Metro garage and Deer Creek to permanently protect and conserve this wetland and floodplain of Deer Creek.



Brentwood Receives \$300,000 Grant for Wetland Project

The City of Brentwood received a \$300,000 grant from the Missouri Department of Resources' Division of Environmental Quality, Soil and Water Conservation Program. The grant will allow the City to design and construct an extended wetland pond north of the confluence of Deer Creek and Black Creek.


