Fire Department and Police Get New UTVs



The City of Brentwood Fire Department and Police Department have purchased new UTVs! These vehicles will allow first responders to access and transport any injured or ill patient located away from roadways. This includes Brentwood Park, Brentwood Sports Complex, and all areas accessible by the trail system throughout the region. This vehicle was funded by a 50/50 matching ARPA Grant from the State of Missouri Department of Public Safety.



From the Fire Department: A Fire Prevention Reminder

October is fire prevention month and all of us should be reminded to make sure our smoke detectors are present and functioning; replace older smoke detectors (past 10 years old at minimum) and be sure to replace the batteries! Smoke detectors will save lives, but they must be present and functioning! 1 per floor, 1 per bedroom – and don't forget to have at least 1 carbon monoxide detector in the home.

Remember: It is always better to be safe than sorry. If you are in a building (of any kind) and the fire alarm goes off, EXIT IMMEDIATELY. Wait for the Firemen to give the "all clear" before re-entering.

Did you know?

Each year, 1 in 4 older adults aged 65 and older experiences a fall, and people who fall once are 2 times more likely to fall again. Follow the steps below to reduce your risk of falling at home:

- Remove boxes, newspapers, electrical cords and phone cords from walkways and stairs. Move coffee tables and magazine racks and plant stands from walkways.
- Use nonslip mats in your bathtub or shower; consider using a bath seat. Install grab bars in your shower and tub.
- To prevent falls, exercise to stay strong and have your vision checked.
- Remove or tape down loose rugs.
- Place night lights between your bedroom and the bathroom.
- Turn on lights before using the stairs.
- Make sure you have handrails on both sides of stairways.

Christmas Tree Recycling – Wednesdays in January: Brentwood Public Works will pick up and recycle live Christmas trees. Please remove all lights and ornaments before placing tree by the curb. The last possible collection date will be February 7, 2024, if inclement weather causes delays in January.

CITY SERVICES

CodeRED/OnSolve Emergency Notification + Weather Warning Alerts

Sign up to receive notifications of impending emergencies, weather alerts, or critical community alerts via phone, email or text. Click the CodeRED button on the home page of brentwoodmo.org or call 314.963.6710 to sign up. Download the **CodeRED Mobile Alert by Onsolve LLC** mobile app for real-time, location-specific alerts.

Brentwood’s CodeRED Community Notification System includes CodeRED Weather Warning, which provides residents and businesses with automated severe weather alerts. Those who choose to opt in to this service will receive flash flood, tornado and severe thunderstorm warnings just moments after an alert has been issued by the National Weather Service.

The City of Brentwood sends other public safety notifications, such as road closures or specific emergency situations, through the CodeRED system. The City of Brentwood CodeRED Assistance Line is 314.963.6710. Please leave your name and phone number, and a staff member will return your call as soon as possible.

There is no charge to residents or businesses for this service.

Knox HomeBox Loan Program

The Brentwood Fire Department offers a 90-day Knox HomeBox loan program for residents who have a temporary special need or physical disability preventing them from opening their front door to Brentwood fire and medical personnel in event of an emergency. Call 314.963.8612.

MAGIC Bus

This free service is designed to transport Brentwood residents age 60 and older or adults with disabilities to destinations within Brentwood and surrounding communities. To learn more, call 314.963.8685.

Deposit acceptable items directly into the medication disposal drop box located inside the Brentwood Police Department lobby, 8 am to 4 pm, Monday through Friday.




