Nancy Parker Tice has served as Alderwoman of Brentwood's Ward 1 since 2020, championing responsible development, improved infrastructure, and transparent budgeting. She serves on the City's Ways and Means and Public Works Committees and has been a leading voice for policies addressing stormwater runoff, park expansion, and fiscal oversight of the Brentwood Bound project.

With a career rooted in nonprofit leadership and public policy, Nancy has held senior roles in operations, finance, HR, and fundraising. She previously led government relations for Washington University School of Medicine, where she successfully advocated for healthcare access, physician licensure reforms, Medicaid rate increases, and expanded medical research funding.

Nancy holds both an MBA and a BA in Art History from Washington University in St. Louis. Her commitment to service extends to decades of nonprofit board involvement, including leadership roles with Promise Community Homes, NCCJ St. Louis, the Gephardt Institute, the Eliot Society at Washington University, and SLUH's record-setting Cashbah auction.

She has received the Humanitarian Award from Promise Community Homes and the Brotherhood Sisterhood Award from NCCJ for her impact on inclusivity and community well-being.
