David Dimmitt is serving his fourth term as mayor of the City of Brentwood, first elected in 2019 and re-elected in 2021, 2023, and 2025. Before becoming mayor, he served as Ward 1 Alderman from 2016 to 2019 and was a member of Brentwood's Planning and Zoning Commission from 2006 to 2016.

David has also taken on leadership roles beyond Brentwood. He is the current President of the Municipal League of Metro St. Louis and serves on the Board of the East-West Gateway Council of Governments. He previously chaired the Legislative Committee and served on several others, including the Countywide Police Task Force and the Building Code Assessment Committee. He's also active in the Missouri Municipal League, where he serves as Chair of the Tax and Finance Committee.

He is a partner at Witzel, Kanzler & Dimmitt, LLC, a law firm that has been based in Maplewood since 2002 and was located in Brentwood before that. David earned his degree in economics from Graceland University and his law degree from Washington University School of Law.

David and his wife Jackie, an attorney at Thompson Coburn LLP, have lived in Brentwood since 2001. Their son graduated from Denison University in 2022 and now lives and works in Washington, D.C. Their daughter, Zoe, is a physics major at Marquette University.
